Jonathon Cote was a U.S. Army Veteran from Western New York who was taken hostage, along with four others, while working as a security contractor in Iraq on November 16th, 2006. He was held captive/missing for 523 days before his body was flown home to us in Buffalo, NY on April 28th, 2008.



**COST** is \$20 per person. Each person will receive a lapel pin for participating, a food ticket good for one free meal, and a pamphlet with information on the ride/event and Jonathon.

**RIDE BEGINS** at 12:00 noon from the high school on a scenic route that will take us about two hours and will end at the Wilson Boat House. (57 Harbor Street, Wilson, NY).
