Austria, Iraq: DNA Samples Belong To Austrian Hostage

U.S. authorities in Baghdad have received the fingerprint and DNA sample of an Austrian being held hostage in Iraq, Reuters reported March 12, citing Austrian Foreign Ministry Secretary-General Johannes Kyrle. The news follows a magazine report saying authorities had obtained the fingers of five Westerners. U.S. authorities told Austria the fingerprint and DNA are from Austrian Bert Nussbaumer, 26, who was kidnapped along with four U.S. security guard colleagues near Basra in November 2006.
