“Crescent Security Group wishes to officially confirm that it has received notification of the most unfortunate loss of the American National, Mr. Joshua Mark Munns who was one of the 5 kidnapped contractors held captive since Thursday 16th November 2006.

All at Crescent Security and those who knew Josh are overwhelmingly distraught at the news of Josh’s untimely end. We wish to offer our heartfelt condolences to his family, friends and loved ones.

Josh subcontracted his services to Crescent Security Group in July of 2006. He was identified as an extremely positive addition to the team, offering experience and dedication to his chosen line of work.

Joshua took part in nearly 50 missions throughout Iraq. He went to virtually all major locations from Basra to Mosul.

Josh was serious about the line of work he had chosen, he took pride in his equipment, his appearance and the perception he portrayed to those around him; he was nothing short of a professional.

Joshua Munns earned the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal and the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary medal during his military service with the United States Marine Corp, serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom II.

The loss of Josh has been a difficult one to come to terms with; his personality and professionalism were second to none.

Crescent Security is thankful to the FBI and Austrian agents for their continued dedication and hard work put into solving this case.

We will continue to work with all of the concerned parties in bringing to justice those who perpetrated this kidnapping and will not rest until they are in the hands of the authorities.”
