“Crescent Security Group wishes to officially confirm that it has received notification of the most unfortunate loss of the American National, Mr. Paul Christopher Johnson-Reuben who was one of the 5 kidnapped contractors held captive since Thursday 16th November 2006.

Crescent Security Group, past and present personnel who knew Paul offer their genuine and most sincere condolences to his family, friends and loved ones.

CSG subcontracted the services of Paul in May 2006 as the team medic. His ability to support the team through his medical skills and his vast ability to heal through laughter could never be replaced nor reproduced.

Paul took part in over 60 missions throughout Iraq, keeping his moral and those around him high in often dangerous conditions.

Paul was as dedicated to his job as he was to his family and friends. He was a gentle giant of a man, courteous and respectful, a trait which earned him the total respect and loyalty of those around him.

Paul was a former United States Marine of four years and an Air Force Contractor.

The untimely demise of Paul is difficult to comprehend; he loved life and loved sharing his passion for life with all, irrelevant of background or belief.

He was an excellent humanitarian, providing assistance to any and all that needed it. He would hand out food, water and supplies to the Iraqi people he came into contact with, often the same food, water and supplies which were for his own use. Such selfless acts were a part of Paul's character.

Crescent Security is thankful to the FBI and Austrian agents for their continued dedication and hard work put into solving this case.

We will continue to work with all of the concerned parties in bringing to justice those who perpetrated this kidnapping and will not rest until they are in the hands of the authorities.”
